### 2002 Universities Act

#### Annulment of assessments

§ 73. (1) The assessment shall be annulled by an official notification of the officer responsible for study matters if

1. in the case of an examination, the latter was registered for under false pretences;
2. in the case of an examination, academic thesis or artistic submission, the assessment was obtained by fraudulent means, in particular, plagiarism in the meaning of § 51 para 2 subpara 31 or academic or artistic dishonesty in the meaning of § 51 para 2 subpara 32.

#### Revocation of Austrian academic titles

§ 89. The body responsible for study matters shall revoke and recall the notification of award if it subsequently transpires that a the academic degree or the academic designation has been obtained by fraudulent means, in particular the use of counterfeit certificates or the pretence of scientific or artistic achievements.
